When we go straight to Easter, we miss the importance along the journey. We miss the anticipation. We miss the journey leading into Palm Sunday. We miss the accusations hurled at Jesus and the humiliation which relates to our own humility. We miss his trial and his willingness to go to the cross for you and me. 


