

Confirmation Covenant

The requirements of the confirmation program are:

- 1) Weekly worship and class attendance with a minimum requirement of 75% of Sundays between September and June.
- 2) Completion of at least 12 Christian involvement activities – with at least one activity completed in each of the five areas of Christian involvement - Service, Support, Learning, Witness, and Worship. Retreats listed below are a separate requirement.
- 3) Attendance at a congregational council meeting once by June of the 3rd year. The meeting can be attended during the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd year. The congregational council meets the 2nd Thursday of the month at 7 PM in the conference room. The student is only required to stay for the first hour.
- 4) Attendance at January retreat for 1st and 2nd year students.
- 5) Attendance at October retreat for 3rd year students.
- 6) Completion of nine sermon notes in the 3rd year.
- 7) Participation in a class visit to a Lutheran Social Service agency in the 3rd year.

It is expected that participants will attend worship services weekly as part of the promise parents made at baptism to bring children to worship each week. It is also expected that if participants cannot attend class due to illness or unforeseen circumstances that the student is responsible for making up missed material.
