Dear Siblings in Christ,

What a wonderful Easter day we were blessed with! Awesome music, many in attendance (greater than last year!) and hearing the Good News that Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! But Easter is not yet over! Eastertide is actually fifty days which bring us to the Day of Pentecost ("Koinē Greek: πεντηκοστή, romanized:



pentēkostē, lit. 'fiftieth'") \* This year The Day of Pentecost is May 19<sup>th</sup>. As we hear the lessons read for Pentecost, we are invited to receive the Holy Spirit breathed upon the disciples and on us in our baptism.

As we leave Eastertide behind, having celebrated Jesus' death, resurrection, and ascension, as we receive the Holy Spirit we enter in the season of Pentecost. The presence of the Holy Spirit marks the beginning of the Christian Church as those gathered that first century received the message in a variety of languages, all as one body, all as one focused on what God called them to do next for the church, as disciples of Christ. Pentecost is a new beginning of teachings, rituals and traditions that have now been carried on down through the centuries to us.

The Holy Spirit calls us to use our individual gifts to glorify God in order to work together as one to accomplish the ministry we are called to do. Sometime though, we get stuck in our historical traditions. We get stuck in "that's the way we have always done it." Yet, we don't want to throw the baby out with the bath water.

On Saturday, May 11<sup>th</sup> you are invited to attend a gathering led by Dr. Jill Peters who will lead us in a conversation of what it is that we at Jordan Lutheran are hearing God call us to do next. What is it that you are passionate about? Where should we be focusing our energy? What is it that Jordan Lutheran is known for in the community, in other words what would the community miss if we weren't here? How can we utilize the gifts that we have been given to pull together to answer God's call to us in ministry and mission?

#### WE ARE EXCITED TO ANNOUNCE...


